



OUTDOOR BURNING APPLICATION

General Requirements for Outdoor Burning: Title 30, Texas Administrative Code 111.201 - 111.221 and City of Robinson Ordinances:

- Outdoor burning application will only be approved for crop clearing and brush burning.
- The area around the pile must be cleared of grass or other flammable materials.
- The pile must be at least 300 feet downwind of any structure or sensitive receptor.
- If smoke from the burn is bothersome to adjoining property owners the fire shall be put out immediately.
- On brush burns the pile may only be tree limbs and brush from the requested land.
- No milled wood or treated lumber is allowed in the pile.
- Wind speed must be no less than six (6) mph and no more than twenty-three (23) mph. Burning may commence no earlier than one (1) hour after sunrise, and must be extinguished no later than 1 hour before sunset.
- The fire must be attended at all times and extinguished no later than one (1) hour before sunset.
- Written notice shall be turned in for a outdoor burning application no less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to burning.
- Burning prohibited.- It shall be unlawful for any person to cause, suffer, allow or permit any outdoor burning of trash, waste, rubbish, grass, brush, trees or other matter within the city, except as provided by the other provisions of this article. It shall also be unlawful for any person to cause, suffer, allow or permit any domestic waste burning because collection of domestic waste is provided in the city.
- Permissible burning; exceptions. (b) 2 It remains the responsibility of the person igniting the burn to comply with all meteorological and timing considerations and other requirements of state law. The authority to conduct outdoor burning under this article does not exempt or excuse any person responsible from the consequences, damages, or injuries resulting from the burning, even though the burning is otherwise conducted in compliance with this article and applicable state law.
- Compliance with applicable laws. It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct any outdoor burning in violation of any state statute, rule, regulation or in violation of common law
